Starting in January 2025, you may notice a small fee associated with certain programs in the Downers Grove Township Senior Programs Newsletter. 

#### **Downers Grove Township Boundaries**

Downers Grove Township is the largest township in DuPage County and covers the following areas: east to County Line Rd., west to Woodward Ave., north to 39th Street and south to the I&M Canal. ## **Dial-A-Ride**
