POLICE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES November 19, 2018

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:06 p.m. in the police department training room. In attendance: Alderman McIvor, Alderman Marchese, Alderman Vaughn and Chief Thomas.

Public Comment and Communications

No public Comment and Communication.

Minutes

The minutes of the September 17, 2018, Police Committee meeting were unanimously approved.

Agenda Memo - A resolution authorizing the purchase of new video surveillance systems for the Police and Municipal Services departments from Current Technologies in the amount of \$101,754. Chief Thomas explained that the current video system is 23 years old and uses very old CCTV technology. Staff is seeking this purchase for a better video system to provide better video clarity and quality also to transfer a video over the current network. A number of areas in the building currently are not under video surveillance, which is needed to protect the officers from false claims and lawsuits. Another reason is that newer laws require mandatory video taping of interrogations and interviews. Similar issues are present in the Municipal Services facilities. Alderman Marchese motioned to approve seconded by Alderman Vaughn. The committee unanimously approved the motion.

Agenda Memo – A resolution to adopt a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding the Peer Jury Program between the Village of Downers Grove and the City of Darien. Police staff is asking to reinstate this program which as operational between from 2000 until 2017. It was administrated and funded by DuPage County. Downers Grove Police Department felt the program had merit and asked surrounding police departments if they were interested in reinstating the program. In the past Darien used the program 12 times per year at \$100 per case. Alderman Marchese motioned to approve and Alderman Vaughn seconded the motion.

Chief's Monthly Report

Chief Thomas reviewed the highlights of his report with the committee. Chief Thomas went in to detail about how the department handles juvenile cases. He reinforced why he feels the peer jury program is important.

ISSUE STATEMENT

A resolution authorizing the purchase of (14) in-car printers from the DuPage County Judicial Center in the amount of \$8,400 using e-citation funds account 24-40-4815.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The police department is requesting to replace (14) fourteen in-car printers which are nine (9) years old and have become incompatible with newer technology.

In 2009, the police department originally purchased seventeen (17) in-car Zebra printers under a grant by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) fourteen (14) for actual installation and three (3) as backup units. These printers have proven themselves to be very durable so we are requesting to purchase fourteen (14) for installation and no backup units at this time.

The grant that offered 9 years ago is no longer available; however, this purchase can be made through the DuPage County Clerk's office at a significant savings. The normal printer cost is \$1,000 each but the County will defray the cost by paying \$400 towards each unit bringing the cost down to \$600 each. The police department would then use funds from the e-citations account to pay for the remaining cost of \$8,400. The balance in the E-Citations fund as of 12-31-18 is \$9,403.50. The DuPage County Clerk's office will also provide unlimited free paper refills for the printers.

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
