7. **RECEIVING OF COMMUNICATIONS**

Alderwoman Sullivan has been in contact with Municipal Services regarding closed sidewalk on North Frontage Road, bordering Carriage Greens, due to downed fence that is in need of repairs by Illinois Department of Transportation. Director Gombac provided an update on the drainage/erosion issues and initiatives being taken to secure fence. Alderwoman Sullivan explained sidewalk is heavily used, a safety concern, and requires City intervention.

Alderwoman Gustafson commented a new streetlight installed at Woodvale Drive & Beller Road. He noted a request is being prepared to add a streetlight at Woodvale Drive & 87th Street.

Alderman Chylstek shared a special thank you to all of Darien for the honor and privilege of serving as Ward Four Alderman the past eight years. He supported clean air, new downtown landscaping, new sidewalks, rear-yard drainage projects, and traffic devices; much has been accomplished to improve the quality of life for residents. He expressed his thankfulness for all the memories, friendships and even occasional disagreements. He wished Alderman Leganski the best of luck as he continues the proud tradition of raising the bar in Darien.

- ...he encouraged all residents to contact their respective State Representative John Egofske, Anne Stava-Murray, and/or Senator John Curran about voting to support restoration of LGDF bill sponsored by Representative Anthony DeLuca; decision will be made by May 19.

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



RESOLUTION

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has recently submitted to the City of Darien the 2023 Community Water Supply testing and schedule. As background information, in 2007 the United States Environmental Protection Agency had passed on to all community water supplies a mandate requiring us to perform specified analytical water sampling.

The Stage 2 Disinfectants and Disinfection Byproducts Rule (Stage 2 DBPR) is intended to reduce potential cancer and reproductive and developmental health risks from disinfection byproducts in drinking water, which form when disinfectants are used to control microbial pathogen. The final rule strengthens public health protection for customers of systems that deliver disinfected water by requiring such systems to meet the maximum contaminant levels as an average at each monitoring location. The mandate continues to reduce DBP exposure and related potential healths risks and provide more equitable public health protection. The rule also continues to evaluate early warning potential of Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCL), and allows the City's system to take proactive steps to remain in compliance.

RULES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH PUBLIC COMMENT REQUIREMENTS OF THE ILLINOIS OPEN MEETINGS ACT

I. PURPOSE OF RULES.

The purpose of these Rules is to comply with the requirement of Section 2.06 of the Illinois

Open Meetings Act that a public comment section be provided at each meeting subject to the Open

Meetings Act.

II. DEFINITION OF "PUBLIC BODY" or "BODY."

For purposes of these Rules, the term "Public Body" or "Body" shall mean the City Council, any Committee of the City Council, and any Board and Commission established by the City Council.

III. RULES GOVERNING PUBLIC COMMENT.

- A. Unless otherwise allowed by a majority vote of the Body, the public comment periods shall be as follows:
 - 1. For the City Council, as set forth on the attached **Agenda template**.
 - 2. For Council committees and advisory committees, at the conclusion of the meeting immediately before adjournment. At the direction of the Body, the floor may be opened for public comment in conjunction with specific agenda items.
- B. Individuals seeking to make public comment to the Body shall be formally recognized by the Chair.
- C. Individuals addressing the Body shall identify themselves by name, but need not provide their home address.
 - D. Individuals addressing the Body shall do so by addressing their comments to the Body

itself and shall not turn to address the audience.

- E. Public comment time shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person.
- F. An individual will be allowed a second opportunity to address the Body only after all other interested persons have addressed the Body and only upon the majority vote of the Body.
- G. In the case of a special meeting, public comment will be limited to subject matters germane to the agenda of the special meeting.

IV. PUBLIC HEARING REQUIREMENTS.

Additional public comments periods will be allowed as required by law in the case of public hearing, subject to the same time constraints.
